

Connecticut AFL-CIO Scorecard Issues 1999-2000 General Assembly

Issue #1: HB 5160 AA Increasing the Minimum Wage. Increases the Connecticut minimum wage to \$6.70 an hour (from \$6.15 an hour) in two steps. **Y=Right.**

Issue #2: HB 5544 AA Allowing for Deferred Retirement Option Plans in the Municipal Employees Retirement System. Authorizes the creation of a deferred retirement option plan allowing members to defer their retirement to a later date. **Y=R.**

Issue #3: SB 1056 (1999) AA Setting Standard Wage Rates for Certain Service Workers: Provides mechanism to set wage standards for certain workers employed by contractors performing state services. **Y=R.**

Issue #4: HR 302 & SR 301: Resolution Proposing Approval of an Arbitration Award between the State and A&R Local 4200 AFT. The General Assembly unanimously approved this arbitrated award in the June 2000 trailer session after the Governor's staff refused to release it for a vote during the regular session. **Y=R.**

Issue #5: SB 1101 (1999) AA Concerning the Licensing of Certain Sheet Metal Workers: This bill gives recognition of the training received by certain sheet metal workers by granting licenses after such training. **Y=R.**

Issue #6: HB 5102 AA Proposing Comprehensive Campaign Finance Reform for State-Wide, Constitutional and General Assembly Offices: his bill would have established public financing of campaigns. Passed by both chambers but vetoed by the Governor. **Y=R.**

Issue #7: Special Act 00-12 AA Establishing a Commission on the Future of Hospital Care in Connecticut, Establishing the University of Connecticut Health Center Review Committee and Concerning Funding for the University of Connecticut Health Center: Besides providing funds to keep the UConn Health Center and John Dempsey Hospital open, the legislature chartered a commission on the future of hospital care in Connecticut. **Y=R.**

Issue #8: Senate Amendment 5099 on SB 515, An Act Concerning Certain Programs Administered by Connecticut innovations Inc. This amendment would have held corporations accountable to meeting labor, environmental and other standards when receiving taxpayer-funded state economic development assistance. Tied 18=18 in the Senate, killed by Lt. Gov. Jodi Rell. **Y=R.**
